More action needed to protect children from abuse

The chairman of Against Child Abuse, Patrick Cheung, says people whose work involves contact with children should be given training to detect signs of whether a child is being abused. He said they should be taught what kind of information to gather in suspected cases so that it could be handed over to the authorities for follow-up action. Cheung also told Annemarie Evans that corporal punishment was banned in schools years ago, and steps should be taken to prohibit it at home.
