#### NOTES ON THE ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT

## 1. Lump Sum Grant

### a. Basis of preparation

The Annual Financial Report (AFR) is prepared <u>on cash basis</u>, that is, income is recognised upon receipt of cash and expenditure is recognised when expenses are paid. <u>Non-cash items</u> like depreciation, provisions and accruals should <u>not be included</u> in the AFR.

## b. Lump Sum Grant (excluding Providend Fund)

This represents LSG (excluding Providend Fund) received for the year.

### c. Provident Fund

This is Provident Fund received and contributed during the year.
