### 1. Lump Sum Grant

## a. Basis of preparation

The Annual Financial Report (AFR) is prepared <u>on cash basis</u>, that is, income is recognised upon receipt of cash and expenditure is recognised when expenses are paid. <u>Non-cash items</u> like depreciation, provisions and accruals have <u>not</u> be included in the AFR.

#### c. Provident Fund

This is Provident Fund received and contributed during the year.
